ITA1121 meets the foreign language and the International/ Intercultural competency requirements.

ITA2220 INTERMEDIATE ITALIAN READING & CONVERSATION I (4.00 Credits)

Classroom practice and exercises are supplemented by laboratory and multimedia activities designed to develop and enhance communicative competence and cultural sensitivity.
