



# MOTION PICTURE POST PRODUCTION, TECHNICAL CERTIFICATE

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**Program Code:** 6345

**Career Pathway:** Arts, Humanities, Communication & Design

**Program Entrance Requirements:** HS Diploma or GED

**Program Description:** The purpose of this program is to prepare students for initial employment as a post-production assistant or to provide supplemental training for persons previously or currently employed in these occupations. The content should include, but not be limited to, instruction that prepares individuals to function as members of a technical team within the framework of an organized film/video production. Instruction includes synchronization of dailies, interpreting and implementing the audio requirements for film production and employability skills.
