Program Entrance Requirements: HS Diploma or GED

Program Description: The purpose of this program is to prepare students for initial employment as a production assistant, lighting assistant, gripping assistant, audio assistant, camera assistant, or to provide supplemental training for persons previously or currently employed in these occupations. The content should include, but not be limited to, instruction that prepares individuals to function as members of a technical team within the framework of an organized film/video production. Instruction includes scenery design, audio recording and playback, stage lighting, gripping, camera, and lighting.
